

Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes

March 13, 2018

Attended by: Mike Konwinski Committee Chairperson, Michele Obaya Committee Co-Chairperson, Shawn Campbell - Communications Director, Deputy Fire Chief Flynn.

The Public Safety Committee met on Tuesday March 13, 2018 and was called to order at 1:32PM. The following AGENDA items were discussed.

1. Inquiries were made to the fire and police departments about budgetary issues. From the FD job descriptions, org & flow charts, and salary schedules were requested for review by the PSC and Finance Committee; from the PD all contracts or agreements for off duty security work, including information on billing practices were requested for review by the PSC and Finance Committee.
2. Order status of three new police vehicle will be revisited after the budget is approved.
3. Background investigations are being conducted on police candidates who will be considered for full-time positions. Candidates for consideration are being drawn from the most current eligibility list
4. The initiative for hiring part-time officers is under way. I will be seeking out and providing information to HR regarding this initiative.
5. The village will consider participating in the National Night Out later this year. More discussion will take place about this event in the near future.
6. The next Neighborhood Watch Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday April 24, 2018 at 7 PM at the rec center.
7. FSA funding, for police officers, will be discussed with the full board.
8. OLD/UNFINISHED BUSINESS: The new fire engine is in the possession of the village. After finishing a few last details, the engine will be placed in service which should be within the next week or so. Our back-up engine should be back with us this week as well.
