

Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes

November 13, 2018

The Public Safety Committee was called to order at 1:30 PM, the following agenda items were discussed.

1. The fire chief provided an overview of the department's budget request. This will be discussed in more detail at the upcoming budget meetings.
2. The student government, fire department, board report was forward to our rec director, Laura Jardine.
3. The fire chief would like the public to know that the smoke detector program is a year round program, and it did not end when fire prevention month ended in October. Between 80 and 100 detectors have been installed so far, and the fire chief anticipates additional installations in the following weeks.
4. Ambulance billing will end up being slightly less than last year (approximately \$320, 000.00).
5. Our newest police officer is in week nine of the police academy and he ranks at the top of his class. He will graduate the police academy on Friday, December 21 and his first full day of duty will be Tuesday, December 25th.
6. The written test for the full time police officer eligibility list will be held on Saturday November 17, 2018, we are expecting approximately 54 applicants to participate.
7. The newly acquired police vehicles are in the final step of being outfitted with equipment and body decals. We are hoping to see them patrolling our street within the next few weeks.
8. Two police academy seats have been reserved for the spring of 2019. We anticipate hiring one and hopefully a second fulltime police officer in 2019.
