Congratulations Chief Michael Konwinski

The Village of River Grove is pleased to announce that Chief Michael Konwinski has been honored by the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police (ILACP) by being designated as a Certified Police Chief through the Association's Police Chief Certification Program. This designation signifies that Chief Konwinski has met the highest standards of competency and conduct for his profession. To be eligible for consideration candidates must demonstrate extensive law enforcement experience, including command and executive posts, a solid educational background that encompasses continuing education and training, and an active participation in relevant professional and community organizations. As of today, there are only 156 certified police chiefs, only 70 of which are actively working (the others are retired). Chief Konwinski is among only a select few Police command staff that have been able to meet the stringent requirements of the program. This program is designed to recognize those law enforcement professionals who excel in all facets of the police chief function. Chief Konwinski shared this with his department and said, "I am sharing this information to highlight the point that continued growth and development is important for all of us, including me. Training and education, promotes growth and development and it enhances knowledge and proficiency which is where merit comes from." Mayor Guerin and the Village Board would like to applaud Chief Konwinski on this well-deserved recognition and this amazing accomplishment!



Dog Wellness Fair

The November 6th **Dog Wellness Fair** co-hosted by Mayor David B. Guerin and the Anti-Cruelty Society saw 43 dogs. Available to them at no cost was: a 1-Year rabies vaccination, microchip, future spay/neuter appointment along with training tips, harness and collar check and giveaways. Understanding the Village's Snow Removal Sign

Winter is almost here and it's time to prepare for the snow. Every block in River Grove has street maintenance signs. These signs have the day of the week when there is no parking on that side of the street in order for Public Works to maintain it.

If we receive 2" of heavy snowfall **on your street maintenance day**, please follow street maintenance signs, as that side will get plowed first. Once it is plowed please move vehicles to the opposite side.

If we receive 2" of heavy snowfall **not on your street maintenance day**, we ask that all vehicles be moved to side of the street with **odd-numbered** addresses. Public Works can then clear the snow to the curb line on the side of the street with **even-numbered** addresses. After the even side is cleared of snow, we ask that vehicles be moved to that cleared, even side of the street so the village can clear snow to the curb line on the odd address side. Once both sides have been cleared of snow please follow your regular street maintenance signs.
