From the River Grove Beautification Committee

The **River Grove Aesthetic Committee**, more commonly known as the **Beautification Committee**, was formed by a group of volunteers and is funded by donation. **Brent Leder, former Director of Public Works**, is currently the president of the committee. Members of the committee also serve as the Village's **Tree Board**. The committee hosts an **Arbor Day Ceremony** each year on the last Friday of April. All residents are invited to attend. Each year the committee, with the help of **Public Works**, plants trees in different areas of town, including parks, schools, churches, and the River Grove Historical House. Sixth grade students from the schools attend and participate in the craft contest as well as with the tree planting. The committee is also responsible for the planning and planting of the flowers on the **Grand Avenue Bridge, planter boxes**, and the **Welcome To River Grove signs**. We could not accomplish this task without the help of the many volunteers who lend their talents to the event. This year's **Planting Day** will be held on **Saturday, May 18th, beginning at 9 am in the Village Office parking lot**, rain or shine. Donation envelopes are enclosed in this month's water bills and are available at the Village Hall as well. Your donation helps us plant trees and flowers to beautify River Grove.
