## FROM IT TRUSTEE ROGER SEWELL:

We are moving forward with plans for a new Mass Notification system for our village which we expect to officially launch in early June. This new system will provide public safety officials with an effective way to alert and warn the public about serious emergencies using the Emergency Alert System (EAS), Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA), the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Weather Radio, and other public alerting systems from a single interface. Residents, business owners and visitors will soon be able to download the Alert Me app to their cell phone to stay informed or they can sign up to receive both emergency and routine alerts by either visiting our website or by calling Village Hall at (708) 453-8000. We expect this upgrade will enhance and dramatically improve our ability to instantly alert the members of our community to any conditions that they need to be aware of.
